GREENEVILLE – The Tennessee Association of Utility Districts (TAUD) held the Region One “Best Tasting Water Contest” at the EconoLodge in Greeneville On Thursday, April 19th. Greeneville Water Commission was awarded the Best Tasting Water in Region One.

TAUD Region One consists of: Carter, Greene, Hancock, Hawkins, Johnson, Sullivan, Unicoi, and Washington counties.

Other Region 1 utilities submitting samples of their drinking water for competition were: The City of Bristol, Brownlow Utility District, Cold Springs Utility District, Erwin Utilities, City of Kingsport, and Lakeview Utility District.

Chance Lamb of USDA Rural Development, Daryl Brady with Congressman Roe’s Office, Lana Moore from Senator Lamar Alexander’s Office, Kim Cordell with the East Tennessee Development District, Laura White with the City of Greeneville, Royce Fout with TDOT, and Reid Fields with WGRV Radio participated as judges for the contest. The drinking water samples were judged on their clarity, bouquet, and taste.

TAUD will conduct the Best Tasting Water in Tennessee Contest in each of the Association’s eleven regions in upcoming months. The winner of each regional competition will compete at TAUD’s 2018 Business Utility Conference at the Gatlinburg Convention Center on Thursday, August 9th. The statewide winner represents Tennessee in the Great American Taste Test at the National Rurally Water Association Rally in Washington DC in February of 2019.
