West Wilson Utility District Wins TAUD Region 5 Best Tasting Water Contest

MT. JULIET – The Tennessee Association of Utility Districts (TAUD) held the Region Five Best Tasting Water Contest at West Wilson Utility District on Thursday, May 10th and West Wilson Utility District was awarded Best Tasting Water in Region 5 for the second year in a row.

TAUD Region Five consists of Cheatham, Davidson, Robertson, Sumner and Wilson counties.

Other Region Five participating utilities were: Gladeville Utility District, Hartsville Trousdale County Water, Hendersonville Utility District and LaGuardo Utility District,

Dr. Dinah Kitchens with the TN Department of Health, Craig Ingram of TN811, and Brian Harstine of Servline served as judges for the contest. The drinking water samples were judged on their clarity, bouquet, and taste.

TAUD conducted the Best Tasting Water in Tennessee Contest in each of the Association's eleven regions over the last few months. The winner of each regional competition will compete at TAUD's 2018 Business Utility Conference at the Gatlinburg Convention Center on Thursday, August 9th. The statewide winner represents Tennessee in the Great American Taste Test at the National Rurally Water Association Rally in Washington DC in February of 2019.
