Fayetteville Public Utilities Wins Region 6 Best Water Tasting Contest

FAYETTEVILLE – The Tennessee Association of Utility Districts (TAUD) held the Region Six Best Tasting Water Contest at the American Development Corporation office in Fayetteville on Wednesday, April 25th. Fayetteville Public Utilities was awarded Best Tasting Water in Region 6.

TAUD Region Six consists of: Bedford, Cannon, Coffee, Franklin, Giles, Lincoln, Marshall, Maury, Moore, Rutherford, and Williamson counties.

Contest participants included: Bedford County Utility District, Belvidere Utility District, Consolidated Utility District, Fayetteville Public Utilities, Huntland Water System, Lewisburg Water and Wastewater, Lincoln County Board of Public Utilities, the City of Manchester, Mount Pleasant Water, Wastewater and Gas, Spring Hill Water Works and Winchester Utilities.

Amy Dennis with Congressman Scott DesJarlais, Clyde Payne of USDA, Congressional Candidate Billy Spivey, and Crystal Manners with the Tennessee Department of Health participated as judges for the contest. The drinking water samples were judged on their clarity, bouquet, and taste.

TAUD will conduct the Best Tasting Water in Tennessee Contest in each of the Association's eleven regions in upcoming months. The winner of each regional competition will compete at TAUD's 2018 Business Utility Conference at the Gatlinburg Convention Center on Thursday, August 9th. The statewide winner represents Tennessee in the Great American Taste Test at the National Rurally Water Association Rally in Washington DC in February of 2019.
