MURFREESBORO, Tenn. – The Old Gainesboro Road Utility District recently met with John Hall of TAUD to receive assistance for upcoming projects. “This was the easiest and quickest process of borrowing money the district has ever experienced” said Patsy Johnson, General Manager for the district. “The entire process, including the conception, approval and delivery of the money only took one month.” John Hall stated at the first meeting that the application for the loan was simply a one page form. My commissioners, in utter disbelief, just kept saying ‘I can’t believe there’s only one page for applying for this loan.’ As promised, the process was totally pain free—John Hall handled everything and the district commissioners only had to assemble to sign the papers. The money was wired to US Bank before one of our projects was even bid! Our commissioners were so impressed with the way the whole process was handled and the district is already replacing service lines. We are so excited about our potential savings in water loss by completing this project as well as the ability to serve our customers more efficiently. Would we do this again?
