

### **Cross Connection Basic Workshop** (*three day class*)

If you need to get a cross connection certificate, then the Basic Workshop is what you need. These are hands-on workshops so please dress accordingly. Successful completion of this workshop will earn you a cross-connection certificate for “Testing and Evaluation of Backflow Prevention Assemblies”. This certificate will have an expiration date of three years. Successful completion of this workshop will provide 12 hours of continuing education for water, wastewater, distribution or collection certificates and can substitute for three months work experience toward any operator’s certificate. Classes begin at 8:30 am and end at 4:00 pm. A written test will be conducted. You must make a score of 70% or greater to receive a certificate. Additionally, you must successfully demonstrate that you can test a reduced pressure principle assembly and a double check valve assembly in accordance with recognized TN Department of Environment and Conservation procedures without written or verbal assistance.
