

Fundamentals of Water Distribution Class *(five day class)*

The Fundamentals of Water Distribution Class is for persons seeking comprehensive training in water distribution systems. It is recommended for those who are employed in water distribution industry and those planning to sit for a distribution certification exam. Topics covered include: TN Division of Water Supply Rules and Regulations, water line repair and disinfection, storage tank maintenance, pumps and motors, cross-connection control, water meters, fire hydrants, valves, flushing, storage tanks, trenches, safety, and mathematics. Classes will begin at 8:30 am and end at 4:00 pm Monday through Thursday. Classes will begin at 8:30 am and end at 12:00 pm on Friday. Successful completion of this course can substitute for three months work experience and six hours continuing education credit toward any distribution system operator's certificate.
