

Fundamentals of Water Treatment *(five day class)*

The Fundamentals of Water Treatment class is designed for new water treatment plant operators, persons planning to take a water treatment exam or anyone wishing to improve their knowledge of water treatment. Topics covered will include rules and regulations, groundwater and surface water treatment processes, and math used in the water treatment industry. In addition to training from experienced instructors, students will receive study material that will be very useful in preparing for the certification exam and as reference material. Classes will begin at 8:30 am and end at 4:00 pm Monday through Thursday. Classes will begin at 8:00 am and end at 2:00 pm on Friday. Successful completion of this course can substitute for five months work experience toward a Grade 4 operator's certificate or three months toward any other water operator's certificate. It also provides up to twelve hours continuing education credit.
