

### **Fundamentals of Water Distribution (5-Day Class)**

The Fundamentals of Water Distribution Class is for persons seeking comprehensive training in water distribution systems. It is not a required class, but is recommended for those who are employed in water distribution industry and those planning to sit for a distribution certification exam. Topics covered include: Tennessee Division of Water Supply Rules and Regulations, water line repair and disinfection, storage tank maintenance, pumps and motors, cross-connection control, water meters, fire hydrants, valves, flushing, storage tanks, trenches, safety, and mathematics. Successful completion of course can substitute for 3 months work experience toward any distribution system operator's certification.
