

Confined Space (one day class)



OSHA regulation 29 CFR 1910.146(g) requires an employer to train employees who enter, attend or supervise confined spaces. This class provides OSHA compliant training for confined space entrants, attendants and supervisors. Individual employers must still document employee training for organizational/site specific procedures and proper use of equipment selected for use in confined space operations. Successful completion of this class will provide six hours of continuing education credit toward any water, wastewater, distribution or collection certificate.
