Block A

Source Water Protection Planning: The attendee will gain the knowledge of the source water protection rule. They will understand how to develop a source water protection plan. What to look for in a potential containment source, and tools that can be used to protection drinking water sources.

Sustainability and Contingency Planning: The attendee will gain the knowledge of how to plan for future disruption in service and ways to keep customers in potable water.

NPDES Permit for Filter Backwash and Sedimentation basin washout: The attendee will learn how to apply/reapply for coverage under the states general permit. They will also gain the knowledge of how to handle the waste sludge.
